WHAT DOES THIS BENEFIT COVER?

- Antenatal consultations
- Amniocentesis
- 2D ultrasound scans
- Antenatal classes with a midwife
- Postnatal consultations with a midwife
- Newborn hearing screening (In or out of hospital)
- Congenital hypothyroidism screening for children under one month old
- R200 per month for antenatal vitamins during pregnancy (Paid from available savings and/or above threshold benefit, acute medicine benefit or the Benefit Booster, subject to formulary)

The availability of these benefits depends on the plan you have chosen.

CHILDHOOD IMMUNISATION

The childhood immunisation benefit is designed to ensure that we support families to keep their children healthy.

DO I HAVE TO USE A CONTRACTED SERVICE PROVIDER?

No. You can use any service provider, however consultation or administration will be covered at the Bonitas Rate.

Please note: The vaccination can only be given by a registered healthcare professional or pharmacy with a valid licence to dispense medicine.

WILL THE BENEFIT BE PAID OUT OF MY AVAILABLE DAY-TO-DAY/SAVINGS?

This is an additional benefit which falls under the preventative care benefit. The cost of the vaccine, including the administration fee of the nurse practitioner will be paid at the Bonitas Rate from Risk.

WHO CAN ACCESS THIS BENEFIT?

The benefit is available to all our members on BonComprehensive, BonClassic, BonComplete, BonSave, BonFit, Standard, Standard Select, Primary, BonPrime, BonStart Plus and BonCap.

WHAT DOES THE BENEFIT OFFER?

On BonComprehensive, BonClassic, BonComplete, Standard and Standard Select:

Childhood immunisations (including reminders) up to the age of 12 according to the Private Vaccination schedule in South Africa.

On BonSave, BonFit, Primary, BonPrime, BonStart Plus and BonCap:

Childhood immunisations (including reminders) up to the age of 12 according to the Expanded Programme on Immunisation in South Africa.

BABYLINE

The BabyLine benefit is available on all Bonitas plans for children under three years. It is a 24-hour children's health advice line.

Parents or caregivers can simply call **0860 999 121** and they will be put through to a paediatric trained registered nurse. The nurse will ask a series of questions depending on the concern raised by the parent or caregiver. Please have your Bonitas membership number on hand. The parent/caregiver will then be given professional advice on what to do next and whether the symptoms are urgent enough to visit the ER or maybe their doctor or specialist. If necessary, the nurse will advise who is the most appropriate healthcare provider to see the child.

Please note:

BabyLine is a general paediatric health advice service and does not provide a diagnosis or prescription. If you feel your child requires urgent medical attention, please take your child to the nearest healthcare facility. Make sure you have your Bonitas membership number available when you call.
